Below are a few requirements we want everyone to be aware of before leading a life group. Also we have a few keys to success for you to have an outstanding life group season.

Life Group Expectations:

We think it is awesome you want to help build what is happening here at The House. With this being said, we have a few requirements for our leaders.

- 1) Every Life Group Leader must finish Framework. Framework is a conversation-the DNA of The House. We want to make sure everyone is on the same page with where The House is going.
- 2) Every Life Group Leader must support The Vision and Leadership of The House by complying with the House Membership agreement which is listed below:
 - a) I will protect the unity of my church.
 - i) What does this look like?
 - (1) We don't gossip about others or put down other churches
 - (2) We create a life-giving atmosphere that doesn't have drinking or profane music
 - b) I will share the responsibility of my church.
 - c) I will serve the ministry of my church
 - d) I will support the testimony of my church
- 3) Every Life Group Leader needs to have been actively involved in a season of life groups at The House. Our process is you ATTENDED, have been a HELPER/CO-LEADER then step into the role of a LIFE GROUP LEADER.
- 4) Every Life Group Leader must attend the life group training which meets at the beginning of each Life group season or watched the livestream video.
- 5) Every Life Group Leader must start and end with The House life group season.
- 6) Every Life Group Leader will be contacted by our Life Group Coaches which is an opportunity for mentorship and growth.
- 7) Every Life Group Leader needs to be regularly tithing to The House.
- 8) Every Life Group Leader must work with the Life Group Coaching Team and The House calendar so we can keep a consistent time and schedule for each life group.
- 9) Every Life Group Leader must attend 75% of Dream team meetings.
- 10) Every Life Group leader is a representation of leadership so to the best of my ability I will be a part of our once a season outreach.

11) Because Sunday morning is the best way to meet new members for your group as well as meeting up with your own group, every life group leader needs to be at 80% of Sunday Services.

12) Every Life Group protects the culture of the House.

Life Group Keys to Success:

1. **Recruit** Each group must be built. People won't come unless you ask.
2. **Faithful** Each group must have weekly contact through text, social media, or face to face. An active group-me is the proof of an engaged group.
3. **Connect** The most successful life groups are not event-based groups, but they have a spiritual and social stickiness which causes everyone to be a part.
4. **Prepare** Be early and end on time. Have time available to prepare any and all material.
5. **Pray** for your group regularly.
